

Introduction


- Ageing of population: degenerative diseases as main causes of disabilities.

Ageing in Argentina, 1950-2050


Projected population according to age groups



Projected life expectancy at 65 years and over. Argentina, 1950-2050.




Disabled population according to sex and age groups. Argentina, 2002-03.




- 2.1 million disabled people ($7\% \geq 5000$ inhabitants localities).
- 54% females.


Prevalence of disability according to sex and age groups. Argentina, 2002-03.




Disabled population according to age groups and type of disability. Argentina, 2002-03.




Causes of disability according to age groups. Argentina, 2002-03.



State supporting and pension according to age groups. Argentina, 2002-03.




Labour condition of disabled population according to age groups. Argentina, 2002-03.



Levels of dependency

- Totally dependent: Help to eat and drink, some also to clean and domestic chores; 110,000 people, 12% over 75 years old.
- Severelly dependent: Help to wash and care, some also domestic chores; 280,000 people, 30% over 75 years old.
- Moderately dependent: Help to domestic chores; 185,000 people, 15% over 75 years old.

Technical help or devices needed according to age groups. Argentina, 2002-03.



Final Recommendations

- To deepen prevention of cardiovascular diseases.
- To improve the pension system.
- To implement community-based programs.
- To support the maintenance of elderly at home.
- To train specialized human resources in the care of elderly in different scientific areas.
- To support research of ageing from the public health approach.
