#### Introduction

- Increasing of life expectancy: growing of elder people, prevalence of chronic diseases and disabilities.

- Objective: To calculate average years of life with or without disabilities in Argentina.




#### Methodology

- Source: National Disability Survery (ENDI) 2002-03.
- Specific disabilities: motor, mental, visual or others.
- Life tables from age and sex mortality rates (vital statistics 2001-2004).
- Life expectancy with or without disabilities from proportions of people with disabilities according to sex and age.




### Life expectancy according to age and sex. Argentina, 2003.






### Male life expectancy without or with some disability according to age. Argentina, 2002-03.






### Female life expectancy without or with some disability according to age. Argentina, 2002-03.






### Life expectancy with one disability at least according to sex and age. Argentina, 2002-03.






### Life expectancy with one disability at least according to sex and age. Argentina, 2002-03.






#### Life expectancy without disabilities according to sex and age. Argentina, 2002-03.






#### Life expectancy without disabilities according to sex and age. Argentina, 2002-03.






### Healthy life years rates (%) according to sex and age. Argentina, 2002-03.






# Male life expectancy with some disability according to type of disability and age. Argentina, 2002-03.






# Female life expectancy with some disability according to type of disability and age. Argentina, 2002-03.
